Year 3 – Volcano and Hurricane Islands: People who have visited or have knowledge of Madagascar, St Lucia, geology, volcanoes or undertaking animation.

Year 4 – UK Landmarks: People with knowledge of: rivers, mountains, castles, UK landmarks, map reading or weather forecasting.
