<p><b>In literacy, this half term, we will be looking at:</b></p> <p><b>Discussion Texts/ Debates-</b> including looking at the Book 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne- With a cold task of- should the boy go in the tunnel? They will then take place in a debate about whether we should stay in school if it is too hot and then write a discussion text on this to present to Mrs. Fox.</p> <p><b>Recounts-</b> we will be exploring the features of recounts and create our own recounts on our beach trip and other events in the summer term.</p> <p><b>SPAG</b> During the children's literacy lessons Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar is interweaved throughout. Over this half term the children will use a range of sentences, use fronted adverbials, choosing nouns and pronouns for clarity and cohesion, use inverted commas and paragraphs around a theme. We will also work on our joined-up handwriting.</p> <p>This is alongside many of the SPaG techniques developed in the last term.</p> <p>In Guided reading and in our Literacy lessons we will be using the book Alone on a Wide Wide Sea by Michael Morpurgo.</p>		<p><b>In numeracy, this half term, we will be learning about:</b></p> <p><b>Place Value:</b> counting in multiples, roman numerals, value of digits, rounding ordering and comparing numbers.</p> <p><b>Addition and Subtraction:</b> add and subtract numbers up to 4 digits using formal written methods.</p> <p><b>Multiplication and Division:</b> recall times tables and inverse up to 12 x 12, multiply two digits and three digit numbers by a one digit number using formal written layout, use distributive law.</p> <p><b>Fractions:</b> counting and converting in tenths and hundredths, add and subtract fractions, recognise decimal equivalents, compare fractions.</p> <p><b>Measurement:</b> telling the time in 12 and 24 hours, money, measuring perimeter and area.</p> <p><b>Geometry:</b> compare and order angles, classify quadrilaterals and triangles, plot points to draw a polygon.</p> <p><b>Statistics:</b> plotting and solving questions on graphs.</p> <p>The children will be taking part in problem solving in all areas of mathematics.</p>
