

School Dress Code

We encourage children to wear our School uniform which is both functional, attractive and contributes to the atmosphere and a sense of "belonging" to the School. Our School colours are navy blue, grey and white.

We like to see the children in the following uniform:

Footwear

We ask you to send your child to School in shoes that are laced, velcro or buckled. Please note that heavy boots or shoes with high heels are not considered suitable for most activities that take place during School time. During the summer we encourage children to wear sandals that are sturdy and in keeping with the requirements of the School uniform (i.e. no high heels or platforms). Trainers are not permitted as day to day school shoes. Please ensure that your child brings a P.E. bag at the beginning of the School week which can be taken home every Friday for washing.

All items of uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name. School Uniform can be purchased from the School Office.

Please note that the only jewellery the school permits children to wear, is a watch and one pair of stud earrings. Long hair should be tied back, sensible and discrete hair accessories and the school does not permit hairstyles that could detract children from their learning e.g. Mohican, spikes created with gel, inappropriate shavings.
