



English		Maths				
<p>In English this half term we will be looking at:</p> <p>The book 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be exploring diaries and letters within this unit of work.</p>  <p>Diaries - To write a diary from either Michael or Kensuke's view from Kensuke's Kingdom.</p> <p>Letters - To write a letter from either Michael or his mum and responses to him being shipwrecked.</p> <p>GPS During the children's English lessons Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) is interweaved throughout. Over this half term the children will use apostrophes for possession and contraction, a range of sentences, choosing nouns and pronouns for clarity and cohesion, and paragraphs around a theme. We will also work on our joined-up handwriting. This is alongside many of the GPS techniques developed in Year Three.</p> <p>In Guided Reading we will also look at some other books by Michael Morpurgo during story time and in our Guided reading sessions.</p>		<p>In Maths this half term we will be learning about:</p> <p>Number and place value: We will be working on representations of numbers, counting in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000, finding 100 more or less than a given number, ordering and comparing numbers beyond 1000 and counting backwards in negative numbers, recognising that place value for each digit in a four-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens and ones), identifying, representing and estimating numbers using different representations and rounding any number to the nearest 10 and 100, reading Roman numerals to 100 (I to C) and knowing that overtime, the numeral system changed to include the concept of zero and place value.</p> <p>Addition and subtraction: We will be focusing on adding and subtracting numbers mentally, adding and subtracting numbers using the formal written method of column addition and subtraction (up to 4 digits), estimating and using inverse operations to check answers to a calculation.</p> <p>The children will be taking part in problem solving in all areas of mathematics.</p>
