- 3. Word count is 1500 2000 words for adults and up to 750 words for under 18s.
- **4.** Make sure you have ticked the relevant age category box and entered the word count for each story.
- 5. If typing your story, please make sure you use a 12 font (minimum), line spacing 2.0.
- **6.** All entries must have a title and be unbound with no illustrations.
- **7.** Entries to be submitted to Waterstones, 118 High Street, Newport, PO30 1TP either by hand or by post.
- 8. Entries by people with sight problems may be emailed to: admin@iwsb.org.uk
- 9. Entrants must be residents of the Isle of Wight or those who commit to attend the Award Ceremony at Riverside Centre, Newport, Isle of Wight.
- **10.** Closing date for entries is 8th November 2019.
- 11. Winners will be announced on 9th December 2019 at an award ceremony and celebration with music, magic and entertainment to be hosted at the Riverside Centre, Newport Quay, starting at 7.00pm.
