



English				Maths			
<p>In English, this half term, we will be looking at:</p> <p>The book 'Kensukes Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be exploring poetry, persuasive letters and an adventure story within this unit of work.</p> <p>Adventure Story: The children will be creating a narrative of being stranded on a desert island.</p> <p>Poetry: The children will be creating a piece of poetry based on the artist Hokusai's great wave picture.</p> <p>Letters: To write a persuasive letter from either Michael to get rescued or his mum persuading Michael to come home.</p> <p>GPS During the children's literacy lessons Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) is interweaved throughout. Over this half term the children will use apostrophes for possession and contraction, a range of sentences, choosing nouns and pronouns for clarity and cohesion, and paragraphs around a theme. We will also work on our joined-up handwriting. This is alongside many of the GPS techniques developed in the year three.</p> <p>In Guided Reading we will also explore Kensuke's Kingdom in more detail. We will also explore other books by Michael Morpurgo during story time.</p>				<p>In Maths, this half term, we will be learning about:</p> <p>Year 3 Multiplication and Division: to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables, to write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables that they know using mental strategies including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers.</p> <p>Year 4 Multiplication and Division: to use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12, to use place value and derived facts to multiply and divide mentally, including multiplying by 0 and 1, dividing by 1, multiplying 3 numbers, to recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations, to multiply two and three digit numbers by a one digit number using formal written layout and to use the distributive law to multiply two digit numbers by one digit, integer scaling problems and harder correspondence problems such as n objects are connected to m objects.</p> <p>The children will be taking part in problem solving in all areas of mathematics.</p>			
<p>Science</p> <p>Our 'States of Matter' topic this half term, will look at the differences between the three states of matter and how materials can change state. We will be cooling, melting and recording temperatures, as well as making ice cream! Hopefully the children will pick up some helpful tips on the best conditions for drying washing too!</p>		<p>India Class Topic Web Spring 1 2020</p> <p>'Stranded'</p>				<p>Geography</p> <p>During Geography this half term the children will be exploring the world using a variety of resources such as the globe, google maps, atlases and maps. We will locate the countries in Europe, the cities in Europe and exploring their environmental regions, human and physical features.</p>	
		 					
 <p>D&T</p> <p>Over the half term, the children will be making dishes relating to a different continent each week. The children will discuss cultures, balanced meals and nutrition to relate to their science work. They will apply measurement and scaling skills from mathematics too, while creating tasty treats and dishes!</p>	 <p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE this half term, we will be exploring relationships. We will look at the types of relationships we have with people, what relationships mean to us and how to deal with different types of relationships.</p>	 <p>French</p> <p>We will be learning about school. We will explore what is in our pencil cases, what our preference of subjects are and what is in the classroom. We will learn the vocabulary and will practice putting the vocabulary into sentences orally.</p> 	<p>Computing</p> <p>In computing this half term, we are exploring taking pictures, uploading and editing them. We will also be exploring how to put them into a document.</p> 	<p>RE</p> <p>In our RE studies this half term, we are exploring the concepts of Good and Evil within Hinduism and what Holi celebrations are about.</p> 	<p>PE</p> <p>In PE this half term the children will be working closely with Mr. Goldsmith on perfecting skills in a variety of sports.</p> 	<p>Art</p> <p>In art this half term we will be creating a picture of Kensukes and Stella looking out at sea and sunset from Kensuke's Kingdom. We will also be making a class picture of the Wave picture by Hokusai. We will be using a range of techniques and resources to complete these pieces.</p> 	<p>Music</p> <p>In Music this half term, we will be exploring Peter and the Wolf and creating our own pieces of music based upon our book 'Kensuke's Kingdom' and the characters within the story.</p>
