


<p>Writing – Firstly, the pupils will be writing a recount letter describing Stanley Yelnats’ first few days at Camp Green Lake. This will include using an informal voice, a consistent tense, using a variety of describing words and phrases and using a wide range of devices to build cohesion within paragraphs.</p> <p>Afterwards, the pupils will write a narrative account of what happens to one other boy after he leaves Camp Green Lake. This will include a well-developed storyline, describing a character using various methods and linking ideas across paragraphs.</p> <p>Reading – The pupils will be reading <u>Holes</u> by Louis Sachar for the majority of the term.</p>		<p>The pupils will begin the half-term by focusing on multiplying and dividing. This will include using the long, written formal methods of multiplication and division as well as using ratio, proportion and developing their understanding of algebra.</p> <p>Next the pupils will concentrate on fractions, decimals and percentages. They will find common denominators using factoring and finding the lowest common multiple.</p>
