<p>Writing – Firstly, the pupils will be writing a persuasive speech from one character in the novel we are reading to another one. Their writing will include using a wide range of clause structures, sometimes varying their positions within the sentence; using structures appropriate to formal speech; and use of modal verbs or adverbs.</p> <p>Afterwards, the pupils will write an editorial regarding a refugee camp. This will include using synonyms for effect; using semi-colons, colons or dashes to mark boundaries between independent clauses and using direct speech.</p> <p>Finally, the pupils will write a narrative from another character’s point of view setting their own success criteria.</p> <p>Reading – The pupils will be reading <u>After Tomorrow</u> by Gillian Cross for the majority of the term.</p>		<p>The pupils will begin the half-term by concentrating on fractions, decimals and percentages. They will find common denominators using factoring and finding the lowest common multiple. They will move on to adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions and decimals. They will also be able to convert between fractions, decimals and percentages.</p> <p>Next the pupils will focus on measurements (particularly reading various scales), converting units of measure and finding the formulae for perimeter, area and volume of various shapes.</p>
