<p>English Linking with our overall theme of volcanoes, we will be creating leaflets, a commentary and writing letters about the human impact of when a volcano erupts.</p> <p>Guided Reading Mrs. Denness will look at a variety of different texts, with a comprehension focus, on Mondays. Mrs. Sharp will be looking at non-fiction texts that link to the topic work, focusing on how the text is laid out and question analysis.</p> <p>Throughout these units we will be focusing on the following key objectives: How the writer's language choice can have an impact on the reader. Persuasive vocabulary and how to convey information and construct an argument. When writing, how to maintain a viewpoint and the chosen level of formality.</p>				<p>Fractions with Mrs. Sharp: We will continue to develop our understanding of fractions: recognizing and converting equivalents, mixed numbers and improper fractions, counting fractions on a number line and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.</p> <p>Shape, Space and Measure with Mrs. Denness: This half term we are looking at VOLUME and revising area and perimeter. We will also look at converting from metric to imperial units of measure.</p>
