<p>Writing – Firstly, the pupils will be writing a set of instructions in which they will use the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships between time and cause; punctuate bullet points consistently; and use further organizational and presentations devices to structure the text and to guide the reader.</p> <p>Afterwards, the pupils will write a narrative piece in which they will describe settings, characters and atmosphere; integrate dialogue to convey character and advance the action; and manage shifts in levels of formality within the text.</p> <p>Reading – The pupils will be reading <u>The Arrival</u> by Shaun Tan for the majority of the term as well as looking at smaller sections of texts.</p>		<p>The pupils will begin the half-term by concentrating on space, shape and measure in which they will be drawing, creating and identifying the features of 2D and 3D shapes; find missing angles mathematically; illustrate and name parts of circles; describe positions on the full coordinate grid; draw and translate simple shapes on coordinate grid plans and reflect shapes in the axes.</p> <p>Next, the pupils will revisit many of the mathematical concepts learned throughout Key Stage 2 in preparation for their end of Key Stage Assessments.</p>
