

| <p>There is going to be a strong emphasis on reading for this year. Children will be expected to have a reading book, read regularly and explore a range of genres and authors. Reading fluency and comprehension are such key skills to master – regular time will be put aside in school for reading and we hope this is mirrored at home. This half-term we will focus upon re-building the children’s writing stamina and SPaG application by using a range of texts to write short pieces of work in contrasting styles, including narrative, chronological reports, persuasive writing and diary entries from different viewpoints.</p> | | <p>During this first half term we will be focusing on place value of numbers with up to 7 digits to ensure that these concepts are fully embedded and understood. We will also concentrate on regaining fluency and recall of key number facts – number bonds to 100, times tables (and related number facts) doubling, halving and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.
