Coming Home – to get us in the mood for Christmas we shall be looking at this lovely Christmas poem by Michael Morpurgo and rewriting it in our own words.</p> <p>Guided Reading Our emphasis this half term is group reading and hearing readers to develop fluency and expression. We shall be using the two texts listed above to look at inference and descriptive language.</p> <p>Throughout these units we will be focusing on the following key areas: Developing use of conjunctions and adverbial phrasing; imperative verbs and expanded noun phrases.</p>		<p>Children will be getting to know what life was like during the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will explore artefacts from the time with experts from Carisbrooke Castle and be able to place these time periods in chronological order.</p>	<p>Number with Mrs Johnstone Year 3 will be continuing with addition and subtraction using 3 digit numbers and exchanging (carrying). Year 4 will finish off adding and subtracting and move onto multiplication and division.</p> <p>Shape, Space and Measure with Mrs Denness: Using the language of position and direction, including that of finding right angles as a quantity of turn, and within polygons; and comparing these with acute and obtuse angles.</p>
