<p>Our book for this half term will be “Holes,” by Louis Sachar. It is a clever multi-layered story of how Stanley Yelnats and his family have dealt with adversity over several generations. This will be the basis for our guided reading and writing; we will be producing character studies of a couple of the characters, writing speeches, explanations and stories. Underlying this writing will be a drive to iron out any punctuation and common spelling irregularities.</p>		<p>We will be looking at decimals – recognising and creating tenths, hundredths and thousandths before moving onto multiplying and dividing with them and linking them to fractions. This will be followed by a unit on percentages – finding simple percentages of numbers and linking them to fractions and decimals. Finally, we will be introduced to algebra by looking at inverse operations, function machines and bar models to help us create and solve simple formula and equations.</p>
