<p><u>Read Write Inc</u> Year 1 are taking part in the RWI programme, and we will be reading and writing about a range of books across the half term. See the weekly 'home' books for the green and red words to practise. Year 1 children also complete a big writing session every Friday linked to our topic work.</p> <p><u>English</u> This half term Year 2 and some Year 1 children are going to be taking part in English lessons rather than RWI. They will be creating character and setting descriptions for their own versions of Jack and the Beanstalk. They will also be writing instructions on how to plant a beanstalk and an acrostic poem. They will be exploring sentence types, prepositions, pronouns, conjunctions and imperative verbs. We will be building on our previous knowledge of noun phrases and commas within a list. We will also be working on further developing our vocabulary.</p> <p>Our Guided Reading sessions will be a combination of whole class sessions sharing and discussing books (Dogger, Zog and Aliens Love Underpants) and exploring RWI books in groups. We will all be reading a range of books during story time too.</p>		<p>In Maths, this half term, we will be learning about:</p> <p><u>Year 1</u> We are going to be revisiting a range of mathematical topics to secure the children's understanding. We will focus on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Money and Length and Height.</p> <p><u>Year 2</u> We are going to be revisiting a range of mathematical topics to secure the children's understanding. We will focus on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction including lengths and money and Multiplication and Division.</p> <p><u>Both</u> We will also be revisiting previous learning, including our recall and application of number bonds, recognition of numbers within 100 and counting in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10 (as well as 3s for the Year 2 children).</p>			
<p><u>Plants</u> Year 1 will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.</p> <p>Year 2 will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
