


<p><u>Read Write Inc</u> Year 1 are taking part in the RWI programme, and we will be reading and writing about a range of books across the half term. See the weekly 'home' books for the green and red words to practise. Year 1 children also complete a big writing session every Friday linked to our topic work.</p> <p><u>English</u> This half term Year 2 and some Year 1 children are going to be taking part in English lessons rather than RWI. They will be creating a recount of our pirate day at Blackgang Chine, pirate list poems and a fantasy story about pirates. They will be exploring sentence types, pronouns and time openers. We will be continuing to build on our previous knowledge of noun phrases, commas within a list, conjunctions and prepositions. We will also be working on further developing our vocabulary.</p> <p>Our Guided Reading sessions will be a combination of whole class sessions sharing and discussing books (Dogger and Alien's Love Underpants) and exploring RWI books in groups. We will all be reading a range of pirate related books during story time too.</p> 		<p>In Maths, this half term, we will be learning about:</p> <p>Year 1 We will focus on Shapes, Time, Position and Direction and Measuring using Capacity and Volume, Mass and Weight.</p> <p>Year 2 We will focus on Shapes, Time, Position and Direction and Measuring through Capacity and Volume, Mass and Weight and Temperature.</p> <p>Both We will also be revisiting previous learning, including our recall and application of number bonds, recognition of numbers within 100 and counting in steps of 1, 2, 5 and 10 (as well as 3s for the Year 2 children).</p>

<p><u>Plants</u> Year 1 will be continuing their learning about plants, looking at the plant lifecycle and the structure of plants, and why they are important to the environment.</p> <p><u>Living Things and their Habitats</u> Year 2 will observing minibeasts and animal's habitats. They will be creating food chains and identifying things that are living, things that are dead and things that have never been alive. We will be exploring how living things and their habitats are dependent on each other, and how the habitats provide for the needs of the living things that live in them.</p>  		<p>Yo Ho, Yo Ho: A pirate's life for me</p> 		<p>In Geography, we will be exploring compass directions and creating simple maps with keys. We will recap on our knowledge of human and physical features from the autumn term to complete these. We will then be naming and exploring the continents and oceans in the world including exploring the equator and poles. We will also be exploring the UK in depth including the capital city, countries and surrounding seas.</p>
