


<p><u>Persuasive writing</u> We will be reading <u>The Wolves of Currumpaw</u> by William Gill and writing a persuasive speech regarding hunting with an established and generally maintained viewpoint; the use of commas to clarify and avoid ambiguity; and the use of commas, brackets and dashes for parenthesis.</p> <p><u>Descriptive writing</u> We will read various pieces of travel writing and produce a description of a natural park or nature reserve which will include using a wide range of clause structure, varying their positions within sentences; using semi-colons, colons and dashes to mark the boundaries between independent clauses; and selecting vocabulary and grammar to change and enhance meaning.</p> <p><u>Poetry writing</u> We will explore and write poetry about animals which uses figurative language such as similes, alliteration, metaphors and personification.</p>		<p>During this half term, we will be revisiting and revising measurement as well as fractions, decimals and percentages.</p> <p><u>Measurement</u>: explore the units of the decimal and imperial systems (e.g. litres, pints, centimetres, inches); learn to find the perimeter of shapes and the area of quadrilaterals; learn to measure and find angles.</p> <p><u>Fractions, Decimals and Percentages</u>: Compare fractions; add and subtract fractions with the same denominator; learn to find common denominators; multiply fractions and mixed numbers; convert between improper fractions and mixed numbers; convert fractions into decimals and vice versa.</p>
