## New school year 2021-2022

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to start this letter by welcoming everyone back after the summer break. I hope that you managed to have some time to relax and have fun with friends and family. Some of you may have ventured to the mainland (or even abroad), while some may have stayed closer to home, enjoying what the island has to offer. Whatever you chose to do, I hope that you all managed to keep safe and well.

I thank you for your understanding and support over the last year and a half of turbulence, including school closures and remote education, as well as the systems that we had in place. We are all keen for everything to go back to normal, and original systems in school are back in place; however, we still have to remain vigilant as a school community.

# Risk assessment and outbreak management plan

I have put our updated 'Covid risk assessment and outbreak management plan' on the school website: <a href="https://www.brighstoneprimary.org.uk/covid-19/">https://www.brighstoneprimary.org.uk/covid-19/</a> Please do take the time to read this, as it contains important information about our health and safety measures as well as guidance from the Department for Education. It will be updated as and when required, and we will keep you informed of any changes. The main 'headline' is that bubbles are now longer required, meaning that whole school events (such as Collective Worship) can now take place. Parents and other visitors are allowed in school, but certain measures will still be in place (e.g. a limited number of parents sitting socially distanced where possible).

## **Drop-off and collection arrangements**

We will maintain the current one-way system at drop-off and home time (enter via the back gate accessed on Warnes Lane, and exit via the front gate on New Road). This system was found to be much safer for the children, enabled school staff to greet each child personally (good for wellbeing) and ensured that children entered the classroom calmly and ready to learn. We ask that parents continue to maintain social distancing as much as possible while waiting to drop-off and collect their children.

The timings remain the same:

**8.15am** Gates open. Children walk around the school field and enter their classrooms. We ask that children don't run around on the playground.

8.25am School starts.

2.40pm Gates open.

2.45pm Home time.

- Y6 children will enter via their external door by the front gate.
- Children enter their classrooms and go immediately to wash their hands.
- Parents exit the playground via the front gate.
- If you wish, you can drop your child off at the back gate where a member of staff will greet them. They can
  then independently walk around the field to the playground where they will be greeted by another member
  of staff.
