Toys Texts

We will be watching the short film 'Taking Flight' and focusing on:

- The main events, characters and key points in the film, using pictures, actions and props.
- Using expanded noun phrases to describe the different adventures.
- Joining and extending sentences using conjunctions (or/and/but/so/when/if/because/that)
- Using the suffix -ed to change verbs into the past tense.
- Writing a diary account from Tony about his adventures with Grandpa.

We will also look at the non-fiction text 'Toys and Games (Ways into History) by Sally Hewitt,' our main focus will be:

- Understanding the layout of the non-fiction texts and the features included on each page.
- Using expanded noun phrases to describe toys from the past.
- Discussing different vocabulary and the meaning of words.
- Using a range of punctuation including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, commas in a list and apostrophes.
- Creating our own non-fiction book about toys.
