Starting on the week beginning Monday 7th March, we shall be starting our sports after-school clubs for this half-term.

This half term the following sports clubs will be on offer:

We shall be playing a few different sports, including basketball, cricket and soft-tip darts, whilst linking them to maths with some SATs-type practice questions.				

All clubs run for four weeks from 2.45pm-3.45pm and will be charged at £2 per week unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, in which case they are entitled to one free club per half term. Collection will either be from Warnes Lane or the hall (please see the table above to confirm). Due to sporting fixtures, clubs may occasionally be postponed. If this is the case, we will inform you of the postponement and the new date for the club.

There will be a limit as to how many children can be accepted into each club, therefore any children that did not attend a club last half-term will go top of the list. If the club is oversubscribed, the remaining spaces will be drawn out of a hat. Any children unsuccessful will be put on top of a waiting list for clubs in the following half term. A text message will be sent out after school on Friday 4th March to confirm whether or not your child has been allocated a place in a club(s).
