Jubilee Day Celebrations

Dear parents and carers,

As the Queen's official Jubilee Day will be taking place in the half term holiday, as a school we will be celebrating this special day on Thursday 26th May. The children will be taking part in activities in the morning before enjoying a 'street party' style lunch on the playground. There will then be a range of afternoon activities to which you are warmly invited.

Children and adults are encouraged to wear red, white and blue on that day.

Morning activities:

The children will be creating portraits of the Queen, a selection of which will then be displayed in Brighstone village library. Other 'royal' activities will also be taking place throughout the morning.

Lunch:

This will take the form of a street party on the playground. Children can order a special Jubilee picnic lunch from school at the normal cost of £2.15 (or free for Reception/Key Stage One as part of the government's Universal Free School Meals programme and for those in receipt of Free School Meals), or, alternatively, they can bring their own packed lunch. Please indicate your choice on the form below and return to school by **Friday 13th May**.

The special Jubilee picnic lunch provided by Chartwells will consist of a sandwich, pizza swirl, potato wedges, carrot and cucumber sticks. A menu is attached for those children with allergies.

We are also asking if children can bring a few extra nibbles to share:

- Koala class: Crisps and biscuits (e.g. chocolate fingers, party rings, etc...)
- Polar Bear class: Fairy cakes and jam tarts
- Lemur class: Fruit (e.g. strawberries, grapes, blueberries) – washed and prepared
- Chimpanzee class: Scones (cut in half with choice of butter/jam/cream)
- Orangutan class: Savoury snacks (e.g. Twiglets, Mini Cheddars, cheese straws)

We are a nut-free school so we ask if you can check all ingredients before bringing the food items in.

Afternoon activities:

Parents and carers are invited in from 1.30pm to take part in the activities on the field. Each class will be providing a royalty-themed activity, and there will be an opportunity to take part in country dancing! We will also be using the special occasion to crown our Summer Queen and King.

Please enter via the back gate where you will be signed in. At 2.30pm, the children will go back to their classes to get ready for home time, and you will be able to collect them at the usual time from their classroom doors.

We hope you can join us for this special day.
