


<p><u>Unsung Heroes</u> We will be responding to the video “The Unsung Hero”. Through these books, we will be writing letters and diary entries, learning the correct formats and features used in these text types.</p> 		<p><u>Decimals - Y4/5</u> Year 4 will be learning about bonds to 10 and 100, making a whole, writing decimals, comparing decimals, ordering decimals, rounding decimals and looking at halves and quarters. Year 5 will be looking at decimals up to 2 d.p, decimals as fractions, understand thousandths, thousandths as decimals, rounding decimals, ordering and comparing decimals, understanding percentages, percentages as fractions and decimals and equivalent F.D.P.</p> <p><u>Statistics - Y3</u> Year 3 will be making tally charts, drawing pictograms and interpreting bar charts and tables.</p>
