Dear parents and carers,

We are offering the following clubs for this half term (Autumn 1) starting w/c Monday 12th September. All sports clubs will run for four weeks from 2.45pm – **4pm** and charged at £2 per week unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, in which case they are entitled to one free club per half term.

Please text the school (example below) by Thursday 8th with the club your child would like to attend. Please note that some clubs are limited so places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Homework Club – this is an opportunity for children to spend time doing their homework in school with support from a staff member.

MAP Club – Mindfulness and Positivity. This club includes learning about being in the moment, daily gratitude, relaxing, guided meditation and mindfulness colouring. Children can bring in a blanket and cuddly toy.

Bell Ringing – this club is about all things “campanology”. Children will learn how to ring the church bells on their own and progress to ringing in unison with others. Children will also learn about bells and how they work. The club will be run by Beccy and Steve Noyes at St Mary's Church (opposite the school). A member of staff will take the children to the church straight after school, and parents will collect their children from the church at the end of the club. If children enjoy bell ringing, they can join the church's bell ringers for their sessions on Tuesday evenings. Beccy and Steve are more than happy to meet with parents after the session to answer any questions and for parents to be in the church whilst the club is in session. Don't worry - the bells will be silenced for the earlier sessions!
