Children will need:

Parents, carers and grandparents are welcome to join us. On the day, please make your way down Rectory Lane from 10.15am to meet us there. You may also wish to bring something to sit on (e.g. blanket or foldable chair). Please be aware that the surface at the site, and travelling to and from the site, will be uneven and may be slippery with mud.

If the weather is too wet, we will hold the service in the church, where you will also be welcome.
