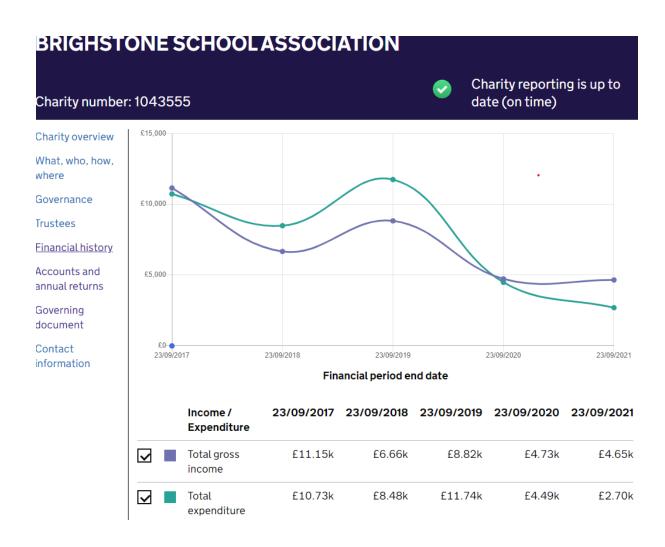

I have encountered difficulties in allocating monies paid into the bank and moving forward, I would suggest each event has an individual financial report. Overall the income and expenditure for the year are correct, however individual event income is not accurately documented/allocated.

The BSA have purchased 2 Gazebos for school this year at a cost of £185, and have purchased 2 new Gazebos for their own use. We have paid £4620.09 towards school trips (some of this money was for trips in 2020/2021). We spent £111 for gifts for the children at Christmas, £99.53 on Easter Eggs, £711.16 on hoodies and t shirts and £243.99 on a Christmas Games day. We also bought each child a Jubilee Badge costing £79.61.

Our accounts were not independently examined last year as were not able to hold an AGM due to covid restrictions however they will be audited this year. We have asked Claire Corsham from Brighstone Newsagents to check over our future accounts. The accounts closed on the 23rd September for this year and whilst prepared and ready, have not yet been filed to Charities Commission. The deadline for this is November 2023 but the accounts will be filed before the of October 2022.
