School Day Times Consultation

Dear parents and carers,

Following the national proposal for all schools to be open for 32.5 hours a week, which has been announced by the Secretary of State for Education, we have been considering the start and end of day timings for our pupils. Even though this proposal is guidance rather than a statutory requirement, schools are expected to implement the changes by September 2023.

The current length of our school day needs to be increased by 10 minutes in order for us to meet the minimum 32.5 hours a week, which will therefore increase pupils' learning time by 10 minutes each day. We are proposing two possible ways in which this may happen. The table below shows the current timings and the two possible proposed changes from September 2023:

	Current arrangements	Proposal 1	Proposal 2
Gates open	8.20am	8.20am	8.25am
Start of school day	8.25am	8.25am	8.30am
End of school day	2.45pm	2.55pm	3pm

While schools are not required to carry out a formal consultation with parents and other stakeholders, we would like to consult with parents/carers and hear any thoughts you may have on what we are proposing, as we appreciate that these changes may affect a small minority in terms of childcare or working arrangements.
