

<p>In English, we will be using “The Misadventures of Frederick” as our key text for writing and reading. Using punctuation for dialogue, we will be exploring how the characters speak to one another and describing their settings.</p> <p>The reading focus will also be on the same book but here we shall be unpicking characters and use of vocabulary and how it is used to reflect the different types of character found in the book.</p>				<p>With Mrs Johnstone, Year 6 will be continuing with project-based maths applications which test out their maths skills in real life situations. Year 5 will be working on geometry which will cover 2D and 3D shapes and position and direction using degrees of turn.</p> <p>With Mrs Sharp, the class will be looking at capacity and also geometry in the context of angles of shapes.</p>

<p><b>Living Things and Their Habitats - Animals Including Humans</b></p> <p><b>Y5</b> will be looking at the differences the <b>life cycles</b> of a <b>mammal</b>, an <b>insect</b>, an <b>amphibian</b> and a <b>bird</b>. We will also learn about the <b>life process</b> of <b>reproduction</b> in some <b>plants</b> and animals; along with the changes that occur in <b>humans</b> as we age, placing these on a timeline. <b>Y6</b> will be learning about the human <b>circulatory system</b> and its role within the body, along with finding out about factors that can have an impact upon our bodies.</p>		<p>All Around Us</p> 		<p>Towards the end of this half term, we will be designing and sewing our own stuffed toy; this will involve practising blanket stitch and learning how to add appendages and sew on a button.</p> <p><b>Key vocabulary: appendage, blanket-stitch, stuffing, template</b></p>

<p>Where does our energy come from? This is the question we shall be asking in Geography. We shall look at the pros and cons of renewable versus non-renewable energy and look at ways to reduce energy consumption particularly in relation to transportation.</p> <p><b>Key vocabulary: solar power, crude oil, replenish, consumption, hydropower, producer</b></p> 	<p>The block of RE for this half term will have the theme of “community” and explore the importance of Islamic symbols and places of worship.</p> 	<p>Y6 will continue with their ukulele lessons with Mrs Jackaman. If any children have their own ukulele, they are welcome to bring it in. Meanwhile, Y6 will be looking at <b>dynamics, pitch</b> and <b>texture</b> based on Mendelssohn’s piece “Fingal’s Cave”.</p> 	<p>We will be using our PSHE “Jigsaw” scheme of work with a unit entitled Relationships with a focus on online relationships.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary: friendship, conflict, worry, texting, emotion</b></p> 	<p>We will be continuing Athletics in preparation for sports day, before playing some rounders, golf and other <b>striking</b> and <b>fielding</b> games.</p> 	<p>Video production will be the computing focus this half term. Children will plan a story board and produce short video clips.</p> <p><b>Key Vocabulary: media, story board, tilt, pan, zoom</b></p>
