Y6 Residential Trip to London

Dear parents/carers,

We are delighted to share the plans for this year's Y6 residential trip to London in June 2024.

The residential trip is being organised by Diamond Adventures, an IOW-based company, and we will be sharing our adventures along with the Y6 children from Wroxall Primary School and Gatten and Lake Primary School, which also enables the trip to be at a reduced price. (While we will be travelling and taking part in most activities together, members of staff from each school will have ultimate responsibility for the children from their school.)

This will be a two-night stay in London from Wednesday 19th – Friday 21st June 2024.

The activities include:

- a visit to the Natural History Museum
- a theatre production of Matilda
- a Thames river cruise
- a flight on the London Eye
- seeing the sights in the centre of the city, including Westminster and Big Ben, the Tower of London, Tower Bridge, Buckingham Palace, the Mall, and lots more
- Legoland, Windsor

Also included in the price are:

- bed & breakfast accommodation at a Premier Inn for two nights
- evening meal at Pizza Hut
- evening meal at Hard Rock Cafe
- packed lunch on days two and three
- ferry and coach travel, including all coach transfers to all the venues and sites

I am sure you agree that this will be an amazing trip.

The original price was £365, but this has been kindly reduced to £349 by the company, and the BSA are hoping to be able to make a contribution to further reduce the price. A deposit of £50 will be required by Monday 16th October, and the final price will be confirmed in due course, along with a letter detailing payment details, including options for paying in full or instalments throughout the year.

No child will be excluded from this trip due to inability to pay, but if insufficient funds are received, the trip may not be able to go ahead. Please speak to the school if finances are of a concern.

Nearer the time, travel details and a kit list will be sent out.
