English

In English, we will be using the book "Historium" as inspiration for describing Viking artefacts (and possibly their own artwork!) before moving onto "The Lost Thing" by Shaun Tan.



In Reading, we shall be investigating Viking **myths and legends** and will read Odd and the Frost Giants by Neil Gaiman. We shall compare the Norse stories to ancient Greek and Roman myths.

Maths

There will be a short focus on telling the time and solving time problems before moving onto looking at decimals, percentages and fractions and how we can swap between them when solving calculations or problems. There will be a brief introduction on **ratio and proportion** before we move onto applying our knowledge of angles and percentages to construct pie charts. We will also revisit and build upon our knowledge of place value and partitioning to help us add and subtract mentally, then finally spend a bit of time **interpreting** line graphs.

Science

Year 5 will be learning about Earth and Space, notably, considering how the Earth, moon and other planets move in relation to the sun in our solar system. We will describe the process of day and night and how this occurs on Earth. Key vocabulary:
