










English			Maths					
<p>We will be using the award-winning Guardian newspaper advert about the Three Little Pigs as our writing stimulus. We will construct reports and documents using emotive language and moving between formal and informal speech to describe and defend the characters.</p> <p>Reading will start with a look at Philip Pullman’s version of Grimm Tales (traditional fairy tales). This wonderful retelling of the tales should sustain the children’s interest. If time allows, we shall then look at nature poetry based on our desert topic in Geography.</p>					<p>Maths will be busy this term with lots of emphasis on multiplication and division and fractions. Children will learn and revise how to use the four operations based on fractions including mixed numbers and fractions of different denominators. Statistics and calculating missing angles will also be covered this term. Children will also be looking at geometry including 3D shape and volume. Y6 will begin to look at how calculations can be expressed algebraically.</p>

<p>Year 5 Earth and Space We will be exploring our solar system this half term. Firstly, the children will consider that the sun, Earth and moon are roughly spherical. Then children will think about how the Earth and other planets move relative to the sun. We will then examine how the moon moves relative to Earth. The children will then develop their explanation of how the solar system works, to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.</p> <p>Year 6 Inheritance Our unit of work this half term will be “genetics and inheritance”. We will look at how and why animals have evolved to suit their environment – and how we know about this. We will also look at how characteristics can be passed onto the next generation and consider why humans want to manipulate this.</p>				<p>This half term we shall be investigating the desert biome. What is life like in a hot desert? Children will be understanding the effects of drought on a desert agricultural system and will be finding all the major deserts of the world using mapping skills.</p>
