

Maths

Maths for the first half of this term will be covering a wide range of topics to help the Year 6 children prepare for their SAT tests in May. Both year groups will be split into smaller groups which specifically target their misconceptions across the Maths curriculum. Mrs Johnstone will be focusing on geometry and graphing, whilst Mrs Sharp will be going over the four operations and fractions - looking at accuracy when calculating and the approach to problem solving.

Science

Properties and Changes of Materials

During this unit of learning, the Year 5 children will use their existing knowledge of the **properties** of **materials** to decide upon the suitability of these for different purposes. We will consider how to **separate** materials that have been **mixed** to make a **solution** and which changes are **reversible** and **permanent**, forming **new materials** as a result of **burning** or **chemical reaction**.

Inheritance and genetics

After SATs, Year 6 will continue with the topic on inheritance and genetics which will includes a virtual workshop Zoom with the Natural History Museum showing us how and why animals have **evolved** to suit their **environment**.
