


<p>In our English lessons, we will start by developing our handwriting and fine motor skills, ensuring that we use the correct pencil grip, and form letters correctly. We will also continue learning some simple spellings.</p> <p>Following this, we will be focusing on grammar and punctuation, using The Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar from Grammarsaurus. We will be learning about nouns, verbs, subject, and subject/verb single-clause sentences. Y2 will then further develop this by using co-ordinating conjunctions to join clauses.</p> <p>Our RWI lessons will continue daily, as well as Reading lessons in which we will read and discuss a variety of picture books, and develop our vocabulary and comprehension.</p>				 <p>Our Maths lessons will focus on place value and addition and subtraction within 20 this half term. We will focus on counting, representing, ordering and building numbers using number tracks, ten frames and a variety of natural and mathematical resources.</p> <p>However, interwoven through this learning, the children will be encouraged to play with maths, developing their number sense and enabling an understanding of the patterns, and reasoning about what they see and use in their everyday lives.</p>

<p>Year 1 and 2 will have a mixed Science lesson this year. Our first topic is Seasonal Changes, where we will consider the changes that occur throughout the months of the year, and the associated behaviours of animals and plants. We will also be thinking about our bodies later in the term - naming parts and exploring how we care for our bodies. We have a visit from Chartwells nutritionist, to talk about the 5 senses that we use in exploring food.</p> 				<p>Our Geography enquiry question is What is the weather like in the UK? We will be using Google Earth and maps to find out more about the UK and its countries, including the capital cities and the compass directions. We will learn about the four seasons and complete a weather study to discover whether the weather is the same in the whole of the UK. We will also think about how people prepare for our changeable weather.</p>

We will learn that objects can be</p>  <p>sorted into groups according to a set of criteria, and can be counted, described, compared and labelled in different ways.</p>	<p>We will be learning folk songs and creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.</p> 	<p>In our PSHE sessions we will be thinking about our families and how they are all different but important. We will also talk about our relationships with other people, discussing friendship in particular.</p> 	<p>In PE this half term we will be using our bodies in lots of different ways to exercise. We will be listening to and following instructions.</p> 	<p>Our RE sessions this half term will ask 'what do Christians believe God is like?'</p>  <p>We will look at the parable of the Lost Son, and the Bible story Jonah and the Whale to aid our discussions.</p>
