#### **English**

In our English lessons, we will continue to focus on grammar and punctuation, using The Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar from Grammarsaurus. We will continue to learn about **subject/verb single-clause sentences**. Y2 will then further develop this by

using **co-ordinating conjunctions** to join **clauses**. After that, we will be reading The Night Gardener, exploring the vocabulary used before writing a **descriptive** passage. We will then watch the short animation Taking Flight, where we will explore the **narrative** and **characters**, before rewriting a small section of it.

Our RWI lessons will continue daily, as well as Reading lessons in which we will read and discuss a variety of picture books and poems, and develop our vocabulary and comprehension.



In Year 1 we will return to **place value**, extending our understanding to numbers between 20 and 50. We will begin to count and **group** in multiples of tens and to **partition** into tens and ones. We will then move onto **measurement**, looking at **length**, **height**, **mass**, **capacity** and **volume**.

In Year 2 we will continue to learn about **multiplication and division**, learning about the 5 and 10 times tables. We will then move onto **measurement**, looking at **height** and **length**, **mass, capacity** and **temperature**.

#### **Uses of Everyday Materials**

The children will be able to test materials for different purposes and begin to gather simple **results** to help us discuss what we have found out from our investigation. We will also find out how the shapes of **solid** objects made from some materials can be changed by **squashing**, **bending**, **twisting and stretching**.


