Please note:

- All clubs will be charged at **£3.00** per week unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, in which case they are entitled to one free club per half term (with the exception of Kids with Bricks Club)
- All clubs have limited spaces available
- Please ensure that **payment is made in advance** to secure your child's place
- Please text the school by **Tuesday 22nd April 2025** with the club your child would like to attend.  
(Text example: George Y3 bell ringing) **Please note: Bookings after this date will NOT be accepted.**
- All clubs run from 3-4pm

**Kids with Bricks:** This is a fun and engaging after-school "LEGO" club now available at **Brighstone Primary School**, this club offers pupils the chance to tackle exciting, educational challenges both individually and in teams. The club costs £3.99 +VAT per child per session and is paid for termly in advance. All club places are reserved and paid for online.
