We are delighted to welcome back Miss Sztypuljak, who taught at Brighstone a couple of years ago. I am sure you will join me in extending a warm Brighstone welcome!

Following the outcome of the consultation to expand SEND provision on the island, which took place at the IOW Council's Committee meeting on 26th June, we are now organising staffing for the next steps. We are working closely with the Local Authority to establish a new Resourced Provision for 12 children in Years R to 6. This provision will be led by Mrs Aram, supported initially by Mrs Brear and Miss Bacon (and then further LSAs when more children join us). The children will have staggered start dates throughout the year, with the aim of reaching full capacity by Easter. They will access both their main classrooms and the Resourced Provision as part of their learning, and the LSAs will support them in when they are in the RP or in their mainstream classrooms.

Now that Mrs Aram has been appointed to lead the provision, we are in the process of recruiting a teacher for Year 3/4 to cover until Mrs Baker returns from maternity leave. We appreciate that this is short notice and fully understand that you and your children will want to know who their teacher will be in September as soon as possible. However, as I'm sure you will appreciate, we were unable to begin recruitment until the outcome of the SEND consultation had been confirmed. I will keep you informed and updated as soon as we have successfully recruited a teacher.

Transition morning will be taking place on Tuesday 8th July, where your child will have the opportunity to meet with their new class teacher and LSAs. Mrs Aram will be teaching the new Y3/4 class, to give the children the opportunity to get to know each other as the new Honey Bee class. On the day, they will go into their current classes for registration first, so please enter the school via their usual classroom door.
