 <p>Our English learning on Mondays to Thursdays will begin by completing our work focusing on sentence construction. We will then move on to use the short video 'Tadeo Jones' as a stimulus for narrative writing.</p> <p>In Reading, we shall be using Pets Tell Tales - Ancient Egypt, to learn about the features of comic strips and how speech and thought bubbles are used to convey meaning and emotion. The children will also get an insight into life in Ancient Egypt.</p>		 <p>In Maths, we will be learning about the four functions. We will spend the first part of the term focusing on addition and subtraction (including the formal written methods of column addition and column subtraction). Towards the end of the term, we will shift our focus to multiplication and division. We will continue learning and have daily practice of our times table facts, continuing with square numbers before moving on to the 5 times table.</p>

 <p>Our topic in Science will be 'Electricity'. We will be making sure that we know how to keep safe around electricity, before going on to construct simple circuits and identifying common conductors and insulators.</p>			<p>In History, we will be exploring ancient civilisations. We will be thinking about what is meant by the word 'civilisation' and going on to find out about early writing systems, early number systems, technology, inventions and the buildings and architecture of early civilisations. We will be dipping into about 5000 years of ancient history! Some of the civilisations that we will consider will be the Ancient Sumer, the Indus Valley, Ancient Egyptians, the Minoans, Ancient Greece, the Shang Dynasty, the Phoenician civilisation and Ancient Rome.
