




English		Maths			
<p>In our English lessons, we will continue focusing on grammar and punctuation, using The Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar from Grammarsaurus. We will be recapping nouns and learning about verbs, subject, and subject/verb single-clause sentences. Y2 will then further develop this by using co-ordinating conjunctions to join clauses. We will link our learning from Grammarsaurus to two texts, Dogs in Disguise (narrative) and The Owl and Pussycat (poetry).</p> <p>Our RWI lessons will continue daily, as well as Reading lessons in which we will read and discuss a variety of picture books, and develop our vocabulary and comprehension.</p>		<p>In Maths, we will be learning about addition and subtraction, ensuring that we have a good knowledge of number bonds to 10 and then 20. We will also explore 2D and 3D shapes, naming shapes, counting the sides, faces and vertices.</p> <p>The children will continue to be encouraged to play with Maths during their Busy Bee time, developing their number sense and enabling an understanding of the patterns, and reasoning about what they see and use in their everyday lives.</p>

We will look at how the different animals can be represented through using untuned instruments and dynamics. We will create and perform sound patterns based on call and response, with contrasting dynamics.</p>	<p>In our PSHE sessions we will be thinking about families and friendships, exploring how families can be different and the positive impact of good friendships.</p>	<p>In PE this half term we will be focusing on our team building skills and undertaking a variety of multi-skills games and activities. We will also be learning about Dance.</p>	<p>In RE this half term, we will be looking at candle flames in relation to their own lives, and how they can be a symbol of important people or events. We will be exploring the significance of candle flames at Hanukkah and Advent.</p>
