Y6 Residential Trip to London

Dear parents/carers,

We are delighted to share the plans for this year's Y6 two-night residential trip to London on Monday 29th June to Wednesday 1st July 2026.

The residential trip is being organised by Diamond Adventures, an IOW-based company, and we will be going with the Y6 class from Wroxall Primary School, which, while helping to build social skills, also helps to reduce the cost per pupil.

The activities include:

- a museum
- a theatre show in the West End
- River Thames Cruise
- London Eye Flight
- seeing the sights in the centre of the city, including Westminster and Big Ben, Buckingham Palace, the Mall, and lots more
- Legoland

Also included in the price are:

- bed & breakfast accommodation for two nights on HMS Belfast
- dinner at Harvester and Pizza Hut
- breakfast on days two and three
- packed lunch on days two and three
- ferry and coach travel

I am sure you agree that this will be an amazing trip.

The original price was £399 but, with a very generous donation of £50pp from the BSA (£850 in total), a very generous donation of £23pp from WightAid (£400 in total) following our successful grant application, and a generous donation of £35pp (£595 in total) as a government travel subsidy, the final price per pupil is £291. A huge thank you to the BSA and WightAid.

A deposit of £50 will be required by **Friday 30th January 2026**. There will be an option to pay in full or instalments throughout the year (via School Money).

No child will be excluded from this trip due to inability to pay, but if insufficient funds are received, the trip may not be able to go ahead. Please speak to the school if finances are of a concern as we may be able to help.

Nearer the time, travel details and a kit list will be sent out.
