As a new school governor, you are not expected to have a working knowledge of the education world in the first instance; what is more important is that you bring a commitment to the role and, ideally, a particular skill; e.g. personnel and staffing, data analysis, financial management, project management, etc. We are an open, enthusiastic team who will welcome and support you and local authority training is available for new governors.

Acting as a school governor can be a rewarding role and it is a fantastic opportunity to have an impact on education and positively influence children's lives.
