










<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Now that we've all got to know each other a little better, we will work on developing the skills of working together. We will focus on tidying up, taking turns and also beginning to recognise our own feelings. We will also talk about why it's important to look after our learning environment and resources.</p> 	<p>Communication and language</p>  <p>The development of the children's spoken language underpins all of our learning in Reception. We will be learning and using new vocabulary, learning to listen to each other and to have back and forth conversations. We will listen to stories, talk about experiences and sing songs.</p>		<p>Physical Development</p> <p>Children will have opportunities to develop both their fine and gross motor skills this half term, through playing with small, fiddly building materials and loose parts or dough, and by climbing, digging, lifting, carrying, balancing and running.</p>

Then we will gradually introduce the bigger numbers 6, 7 and 8 and the number 0. We will build on our previous number play and exploration, adding small groups and beginning to recognise patterns. Throughout the weeks we will also explore mass, capacity, length, height and time, learning and using new mathematical vocabulary.</p> 
<p>Understanding the World</p> <p>We will encourage children to explore and observe their natural environment, with a focus on the season of winter.</p> <p>We will learn a little about some of the different celebrations happening around the world. We will also explore maps and pictures of different locations around the world.</p> 	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p>  <p>This half term we will continue to look at different ways of making marks in the Creative Area, which the children can then use independently in their own creations. We will look at some of Stushie's Winter artwork.</p> <p>We will continue to sing songs and respond to music from a variety of genres.</p>		<p>R.E.</p>  <p>This half term, we will talk about special people in our lives.
