


We will explore a local natural environment and create information pages written in the second person, inspired by the Wonder Garden. In terms of punctuation and grammar, we will specifically focus on subordinating conjunctions and the use of possessive apostrophes.</p> <p>Reading: we shall be exploring the language and imagery of this amazing book and making our own interpretations of the text.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths, we will continue to learn about and deepen our understanding of fractions. We will be working with mixed numbers and improper fractions as well as learning to find a fraction of an amount.</p> <p>We will also be covering mass and capacity.</p> 			
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p>  <p><u>Animals (including humans)</u> We will be continuing with our movement and nutrition learning, finding out about how the body uses energy and what constitutes a balanced diet.</p> <p>We will then go on to explore the role of the digestive system and comparing teeth and diets of different animals as part of a food chain.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Honey Bee Class Topic Web Summer 1 2025/26</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Geography</p> <p><u>Who Lives in Antarctica?</u> This term, we investigate the remote continent of Antarctica, its unique physical features and human interactions. We will learn that while no one lives in Antarctica permanently, scientists and tourists visit, and that the continent experiences harsh climates, blizzards and even has an active volcano. We will also include a historical perspective, learning about the explorer Ernest Shackleton.</p>
