

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will focus on **self-care**. We will talk about why personal **hygiene** is so important and explore ways that we can keep **healthy** and **safe**.



Communication and Language



The development of the children's spoken language underpins all of our learning in Reception. We will be learning and using new vocabulary, learning to listen to each other and to have back and forth conversations. We will listen to stories, talk about experiences and sing songs.

Physical Development

Children will have opportunities to develop both their fine and gross motor skills this half term, through playing with small, fiddly building materials and loose parts or dough, and by climbing, digging, lifting, carrying, balancing and running.



Literacy

Our day is filled with stories, songs and rhymes. We promote a love of reading, and there are books available in all areas. We will continue to learn new sounds and apply them in our reading and writing. We will begin to write sentences, which can be read back, and children will be encouraged to write independently as much as possible.

Maths

We will extend our learning about numbers up to 20 and beyond using ten frames, observing what we see and noticing patterns. We will explore spatial reasoning, thinking about how shapes and objects can be turned and manipulated.



Understanding the World

As we move through spring, we will observe and notice the changes in our own environment and watch our plants grow. We will be reading lots of stories about **gardens and nature**, and thinking about our own wonderful **planet** and why it's important to look after it and all of its amazing plants and creatures.

We will continue to read stories about characters from the **past**, and also from different **cultures**, and compare other people's lives to our own.



Expressive Arts and Design



This half term we will explore a variety of craft techniques, such as cutting, joining and threading, which the children can use in their own creations. We will continue to sing songs, and make and respond to music from a variety of different cultures.
