Dear parents and carers,

The following clubs are available for next half term, all starting in the second week back, w/c 8<sup>th</sup> June.

Please note:

- All clubs will be charged at **£3.00** per week unless your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, in which case they are entitled to one free club per half term
- Please ensure that **payment is made in advance** to secure your child's place
- Please text the school by **Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May** with the club/s your child would like to attend.  
(Text example: George Y3 bell ringing) **Please note: Bookings after this date will NOT be accepted.**
- All clubs run from 3-4pm
- **Spaces are limited** in some clubs and so you may be put on a waiting list for next time.

**MaP Club:** (Mindfulness and Positivity) – children will learn about daily gratitude, guided meditation, relaxation techniques and growth mindset. Children can bring in a blanket and one cuddly toy for these sessions.

**Junior Stompers:** children will learn line dancing routines. Line dancing helps children build confidence, coordination, emotional regulation, and a sense of belonging through fun, structured movement.

**Art club:** Children will follow YouTube tutorials and/or use books to help them with drawing, origami and crafts or do mindfulness colouring.

**Performance skills:** Children will be playing fun drama games and activities that build confidence, encourage strong teamwork and improve performance skills.

**Golf:** Dan from Freshwater Golf Club will be teaching children all about golf to help children develop concentration, hand eye coordination, patience, and resilience while promoting physical activity.

**High School Prep:** we will look at topics such as online safety, peer pressure, timetables and organisation skills as well as discuss any worries children may have.
