Dear parents/carers,

As you know, the **whole school** performance of 'You Are Special' is on Wednesday 22nd July at 2pm and Thursday 23rd July at 6pm. Your child will be performing with their class on the stage and in the chorus.

We would like your help in providing the costumes for your children. These are the different characters and the costumes the children will need across the school:

<u>Main Parts</u>	<u>Costume</u>
Narrators	Smart casual outfits
Punchinello	Three-quarter-length trousers; jacket that's slightly too small; cap or hat
Eli	Shirt with sleeves rolled up; apron or overalls
Lucia	Plain dress
Snooty Wemmick	Hat, with flowers if appropriate; good quality coat with large gold buttons added
Sniggering Wemmick	Dress or trousers and shirts with brightly-coloured buttons/scarves/ties
Gossipy Wemmick	Overalls or dungarees; ordinary coat and flat cap; can wear a colourful scarf
Celebrity	Something sparkly, with padded shoulders
Personal Assistant (PA)	Smart suit or separate trousers and jacket; large tie; large glasses and clipboard
Entrepreneur	Business-like outfit and oversized sunglasses
Circus Wemmicks	Striped top and plain leggings for one; plain top and striped leggings for the other
Photographer	Waterproof jacket and cap
Poet	Top hat and tail coat (if possible), cravat and monocle
Model Wemmick	Stylish, fashionable outfit
Nosey Wemmick	Three-quarter-length trousers; jacket slightly too big; glasses with false nose attached
Mrs Chips	Tatty overalls or mucky tracksuit
Mr Bit	Old jeans and shirt
Helpful Wemmick	Brightly-coloured trousers and top
Dot Wemmicks	Baggy, slightly short trousers, T-shirts and waistcoats, all rather worn looking

Market-Trader Wemmick	Half apron with a headscarf or butcher's/baker's hat
Child Wemmick	Shorts or dungarees and plain T-shirt
Messenger	Trousers/skirt, blazer and peaked cap

<u>Year Group</u>	<u>Characters</u>	<u>Costume</u>
Reception Year 3 Year 4 Year 5 Year 6	Wemmicks (like puppets or wooden dolls)	Trousers/skirts/dungarees (any colour), shirts/t-shirts (any colour), plus any of the following: braces, jackets, waistcoats, hats/flat caps, scarves, bows, ribbons and/or large buttons. Each Wemmick has to look different, so the clothes could be the right size, or too large, or too small. Some could be scruffy.
Year 1 Year 2	All Star Wemmicks	As above, but with a bit of sparkle, glitter and pizzazz.

If you have any problems with providing the costume items suggested, please see your class teacher and we will do our best to help. Costumes should be brought into school on Monday 20th July in a named bag.

For the evening performance, your child needs to arrive at school at 5.30pm to get changed into their costume. After each performance, the children will be brought back to school to get changed before being collected from their classrooms.

If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask your child's teacher.

Entrance is by ticket only and can be ordered through Mrs Pelosi at £2.50 per ticket (proceeds will go to the BSA). The allocation of the tickets is three per family on a first come, first served basis. Please specify which performance you would like on the form below.
